

Residential Fire Safety Equipment Report

As a tenant in a multi-unit residential facility, you are required to complete this report and submit it to our office annually. We recommend that detectors be tested in the spring and fall—same time you change the clocks for daylight savings time. Portable fire extinguishers must be inspected once a year and hydrostatically tested every five years (if applicable).

This form must be completed and returned no later than January 31st. If the alarms are not working as they should, please contact our office to put in a work order to have it repaired or replaced. Normal necessary repairs/replacements are covered with your rent. We must pass along the \$65 we are billed for testing if you can't complete this on your own and actual costs for missing/broken detectors.
